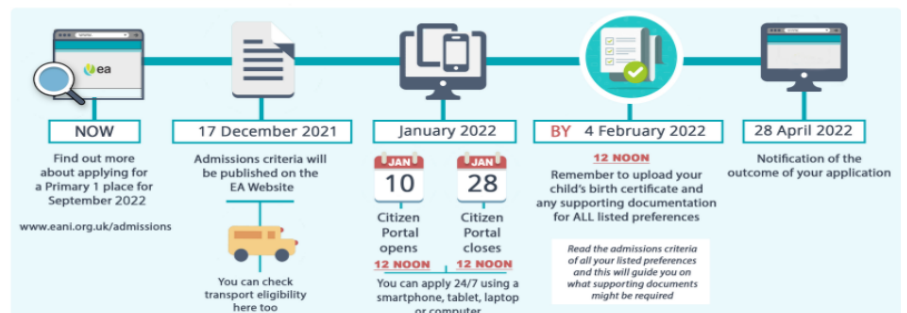
Diary Dates
