key points to remember for our return on Thursday 26th August 2021:

- NO Dinners will be served on the first three days Thursday 26th, Friday 27th and Tuesday 31st August and pupils will finish at earlier times.
- There will be a hot dinner served daily starting on Wednesday 1st September. The new menu will be uploaded to the School Jotter app on Friday 27th Aug.
- Please look at the diagrams and note the exact Collection Point 1, 2 or 3 and start/end times for your son/sons.
 (Week 2 times are also attached below).
- Temperatures of pupils will continue to be taken each morning as they enter the classroom.
- There will be NO BELLS in the morning or at home time. Children MUST arrive at school at their start time. Please be on time for pick up.
- P5-7 Swimming and Breakfast Club will remain on hold until further notice.
- Extended Schools will commence in early October 2021.
- Parents (with the exception of Primary 1) will be required to remain outside the school perimeter.
- Parents will be discouraged from congregating at the school gates with staggered start and end times.
- The initial focus will be on the pastoral needs of our pupils, their health and wellbeing and the enhancement of a 'reconnect' between pupil and school, helping our pupils settle back into the school day.
- Homework will start on Wednesday 1st September 2021. Homework books will be sent home daily.
- School bags can now be brought into school. However, it is preferred that pupils bring book bags rather than bulky backpacks to school as space is limited in the classrooms.
- NO Footballs will be permitted in the playground. Each class will continue to operate in its own distinct group.
- If your child is sick or has cold/temperature you MUST NOT send him to school. If your child is unwell at school, he will be immediately sent home.
- We are closed on the Bank Holiday Monday 30th August 2021.

HCB School Uniform consists of:

- Black jumper (with school crest)
- Red Polo shirt
- Plain Black trousers
- Plain black shoes/trainers (no stripes/designs)
- Black shorts can be worn in the summer months
- ♣ Parents/guardians are asked to label all items of clothing clearly with their child's name.
- ♣ On health and safety grounds, we do not allow children to wear jewellery in school (watches are not considered items of jewellery and may be worn). Earrings ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- Hair: Lines or dyes ARE NOT PERMITTED.





NB: Pupils can continue to come to school in their PE Gear on the day that they have PE.

As you may be aware, there was a recent update (12/08/21) from the Education Minister.

She stated:

- The removal of the requirement for schools to use formal bubbles should provide schools with more
 flexibility allowing pupils to move around into different classrooms and facilities. However, in order
 to support effective contact tracing, schools will be asked to ensure pupils remain in consistent
 groups, where possible.
- Schools should continue to consider their own local circumstances and what measures they can put in place to minimise transmission of the virus using their own experiences of the last year.

Other mitigating measures operating in schools are:

- the advice to parents that pupils with symptoms should not attend school.
- advice to schools to maintain a cautious approach in organising gatherings in schools such as school assemblies.
- Parents are asked to keep to social distancing guidelines and avoid congregating at the school gates
- Continuing promotion of good hand and respiratory hygiene measures
- Regular asymptomatic testing continues to be offered and encouraged for all school staff and all students in post primary and special schools.
- Young people aged 5 to 17 who are not fully vaccinated and are identified as a close contact should self-isolate and book a PCR test. If the PCR test result is negative they can end their selfisolation. Should they develop symptoms they should self-isolate until they have a result from their PCR test. If the PCR test is positive, they should complete a full 10 days of self-isolation. If the PCR test is negative, they can stop isolating.

Please ensure that you complete and sign the <u>Pupil Information and Consent Form</u> that every child will take home on **Thursday 26**th **August** inside a poly pocket (**Copy Attached below**). Please fill in the required details ASAP and return it to the class teacher in the poly pocket.




