Parent Information and Key Dates for School return

- → School Dinners: The current price of a school meal is £2.60. Your son may be entitled to Free School Meals. To check this, you can contact the Education Authority Belfast on 02890564000 and ask to speak to someone in the department of free school meals and uniform grants. Alternatively, apply online via https://www.eani.org.uk/financial-help/free-school-meals-uniform-grants
- Packed Lunches: Sandwiches or a bread based item, Fruit / vegetables/ yoghurt, Water / milk / non fizzy juice and one treat.
- Water: All children are encouraged to carry a plastic bottle of water in their schoolbags to drink throughout the day. No flavoured water!
- Healthy eating at Holy Cross should not be seen in isolation. The Healthy Eating Policy of Holy Cross Boys' is an integral part of our PDMU policy. It involves a partnership between teachers and parents.

Mid-Morning Breaks should consist of fruit and/or vegetables; bread based snacks with a sugar free filling e.g. plain bread sticks, bread rolls, sandwiches of ham, tuna, cheese etc. (Scones, muffins or pancakes can be used occasionally as they contain some sugar and may cause tooth decay if taken frequently). The only drinks taken should be either milk or water.



Healthy Lunch Choices: In PDMU (Personal Development, Mutual Understanding) lessons we are trying to develop the idea of a balanced diet and healthy lifestyle which will be carried on into adult life. For this reason, we encourage pupils to include a piece of fruit, sandwiches, and a non-fizzy or sugar free drink in their lunch as well as a treat (biscuit).

HCB School Uniform

Pupils will wear their full school uniform on the first day back (Friday 26th August 2021).

HCB School Uniform consists of:

- Black jumper (with school crest)
- Red Polo shirt
- Plain Black trousers
- Plain black shoes/black trainers (no stripes/designs)
- Black shorts can be worn in the summer months
- Parents/guardians are asked to label all items of clothing clearly with their child's name.
- ♣ On health and safety grounds, we do not allow children to wear jewellery in school (watches are not considered items of jewellery and may be worn). Earrings ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- Hair: Lines or dyes ARE NOT PERMITTED.





Physical Education

- → All pupils will wear their full school uniform to school on PE days.
- ♣ P3-7 pupils will now bring in their PE Gear to school (and change in class) on the days that they have PE class. P1 & 2 pupils will take off their jumper and change footwear for PE.

Attendance

- Holy Cross Boys' PS is committed to a positive policy of encouraging pupils to attend school regularly. The school will work with parents, pupils and outside agencies to secure this aim.
- Rewarding Pupils with Excellent and Improved Attendance: Pupils who attend School for 5 days of the week will automatically receive a Written Homework Pass for the following Thursday night. Our Student Council brought in this initiative recently and it has helped to encourage improved attendance for many pupils. We also celebrate all our pupils who put in a great effort with attendance at every opportunity throughout the school year. We reward these pupils at the mid and end of each term with prizes.
- ♣ Poor Attendance: Pupils who have a history of poor attendance will continue to be monitored on a regular basis. Pupils that had poor attendance for the last school year 2021-2022 will be sent home a letter in early September to remind parents of the importance of good attendance. Pupils are encouraged not to take holidays during term time. If a pupil goes on a holiday during term time, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised.
